In 2018 and 2019, the Goethe-Institut, in cooperation with LIA Leipzig International Art Programme, offer artists from Nordic countries. residencies at Leipziger Baumwollspinnerei for two 3-months-periods.

Residency Period I:November 2018 - January 2019Residency Period II:February - April 2019

The Goethe-Institut is the cultural institute of the Federal Republic of Germany. We promote knowledge of the German language abroad and foster international cultural cooperation. We convey a comprehensive image of Germany by providing information about cultural, social and political life in Germany. This project is funded by the Goethe-Institutes in the Nordic Countries and managed by Goethe-Institut Denmark.

LIA-Leipzig International Art Programme (<u>www.LIAp.eu</u>) is a ten year old art programme and nonprofit artist residency at the Spinnerei Leipzig, a 10 hectare big art factory of studios, galleries and art institutions.

We offer an 80 m² furnished studio to live and work in and a one-time payment of $500 \in$ towards travel costs and material.

The stipend also includes a group show in January for the first round and in April for the second round during the Gallery Tours of the Spinnerei (<u>www.spinnerei.de</u>)

Full payment for the production of one print at Atelier für Radierung Maria und Vlado Ondrej (www.radierung-leipzig.de) etching studio is included in the residency. This project aims at a Northern European print edition being produced of six fellows in total to be part of a traveling exhibition. Please note, the team of the print studio especially works with artists who do not work in the field of print making. They help and teach everything necessary.
