

**10 Years Herzliya-Leipzig Sister City Partnership**  
Open Call for a One Month Residency in Leipzig  
Residency Period: 1st to 31st March  
**Regarding artists working and living or having a Herzliya background**

LIA-Leipzig International Art Programme ([www.LIAp.eu](http://www.LIAp.eu)) is a nonprofit artist residency at the Spinnerei ([www.Spinnerei.de](http://www.Spinnerei.de)) Leipzig, a 10 hectare big art factory of studios, galleries and art institutions. It is a place for experiment and learning within an international and local art community. The thirteen year old art programme and nonprofit artist residency hosts international studios. The Programme philosophy is to create impulses through exchanging ideas and knowledge as well as artistic traditions with the local art community and learning in cooperations. We believe that leaving a comfort zone opens new perspectives, international exchange broadens mind sets and widens creative approaches. The confrontation with the other fosters new ways of thinking and experimenting. It allows tolerance and new ways of thinking. Project partner besides the Atelier für Radierung is the Grassi Museum für Völkerkunde zu Leipzig (<https://grassi-voelkerkunde.skd.museum>) and its anthropological collection the artists will be allowed to work with. It belongs to the Staatliche Kunstsammlungen Dresden, the federal collection of Saxony. We also cooperate with the Deutsches Hygiene Museum in Dresden and musicians of the Gewandhaus Philharmonic Orchestra Leipzig.

The fellowship includes an **80 m<sup>2</sup> furnished studio to live and work** in at the international artists in residency LIA and the participation with other international residents in LIA programme (exhibition, care taker, critic and studio visits, excursions). For full programme details please see the LIA web-site application. The studio fee of 1.250 € for one month is fully covered as partially travel costs will be taken care of.

- your e-mail must not exceed 6 MB and must be sent in one piece
